

AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC EXCHANGE

BETWEEN

**THE ARCHITECTURAL INSTITUTE OF JAPAN,
KYUSHU CHAPTER**

AND

**THE ARCHITECTURAL INSTITUTE OF KOREA,
BUSAN_ ULSAN_ GYEONGNAM CHAPTER**

November 16th, 2007

WHEREAS:

- the Architectural Institute of Japan (AIJ), Kyushu Chapter is the academic body for architectural professors, architectural engineers and architects in Japan;
- the Architecture Institute of Korea (AIK), Busan_Ulsan_Gyeongnam Chapter is the academic body for architectural professors, architectural engineers and architects in the Republic of Korea.

RECOGNIZING THAT:

- architects and architectural scholars throughout Japan and Republic of Korea seek integrity, professionalism and competence in the academia of architecture and offer society the skills and stewardship necessary to develop and protect the academic knowledge.

THE AIJ, KYUSHU CHAPTER AND THE AIK, BUSAN_ULSAN_GYEONGNAM CHAPTER AGREE TO COOPERATE:

to the extent that resources and priorities reasonably permit

- to exchange institute members;
- to organize lectures, seminars, exhibitions and symposia;
- to conduct joint research projects;
- to exchange information and academic publications.

In each specific case, the AIJ, Kyushu Chapter and the AIK, Busan_Ulsan_Gyeongnam Chapter shall prepare by mutual deliberation a detailed program concerning specific steps and measures for implementing above.

THIS AGREEMENT IS EFFECTIVE:

in the event that this agreement continues between the AIJ, Kyushu Chapter and the AIK, Busan_Ulsan_Gyeongnam Chapter, it shall be effective for five years from the date of signature unless abrogated by either party and may be revised at any time or may be continued by mutual agreement.
